

PROGRAM INFORMATION

The White Pine School Scholarship Program is an experiential pre-college summer scholarship program for one talented student from geographic area of the former White Pine School.

- Choose from a variety of hands-on camps and career explorations in engineering, science and technology, and computing.
- Learn about exciting career opportunities.
- Interact with alumni and role models to get first-hand accounts of the diverse careers in the fields you're interested in.
- Experience college life—stay in a residence hall, explore campus, and meet other students with similar backgrounds and interests.

Upon request, arrangements can be made for you to speak with faculty from disciplines or areas in which you have special interests, as well as admissions and financial aid staff.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications will be considered on a first-come, first served basis, if they show merit. Late applications may be considered. You can also request additional applications from your school counselor, or by emailing rmmartel@mtu.edu. Send your completed application, including the required short responses to questions, and a copy of your unofficial school transcript AS SOON AS POSSIBLE—by scan to rmmartel@mtu.edu, or fax to 906-487-1136, or hard-mail to the contact info at the bottom of this page.

COST

One selected participant will receive a scholarship valued at up to \$1,000, which covers all tuition costs, classroom supplies, and room and board for one week.

TRANSPORTATION

You are responsible for your own transportation costs.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Open to students in grades 6–11 (as of fall 2019) only from the White Pine School geographic area (or near-by). Participants are selected on a competitive basis. Preference will be given to applicants who are academically successful and have demonstrated a strong interest in STEM fields (science, technology/computers, engineering, and math). The selection committee also reviews involvement in extracurricular activities and outside interests or responsibilities, short responses to questions, your teacher's recommendation, and school transcripts. Neatness, accuracy, and following directions will also be considered.
