ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP: Beginning in the year 2000, the Ontonagon Valley Sportsmen's Club and Mrs. Kathy Johnson established two (2) \$500 scholarships in the memory of one of the founding members of the organization. Mr. Johnson succumbed to cancer only three months after assisting in the formation of the Sportsmen's Club in the Fall of 1998. The scholarship is intended to be given to one male and to one female pursuing any type of post high school studies.

ABOUT THE SPORTSMEN'S CLUB: A 250+ member non-profit organization operated and managed by local sportsmen and women from all walks of life dealing with issues and projects that effect every type of outdoor activity in or near the Ontonagon River Watershed, that is, the area bounded by Kenton to the east, the Cisco Chain of Lakes to the south, Merriweather to the west and Lake Superior to the north.

ELIGIBILTY: Scholarship eligibility is open to graduating seniors from any of the High Schools located in the Ontonagon River Watershed, i.e., Ontonagon, Watersmeet or Ewen-Trout Creek. The graduating senior will be eligible as long as he or she is intent on pursuing some type of post high school studies, i.e., college, trade school, or any other type of post high school course of study. Those students awarded the scholarship may request payment once one semester or term of study has been completed and the student intends to continue his or her enrollment.
