SCHOLARSHIPS DEADLINES FROM OCT 31 – DEC 31

1) SP Scholarship - \$10,000 - 10 Awards (Deadline: October 31, 2020)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school student planning to attend college in September 2021.
- B) Answer the Essay question on the sponsors website.

2) Opportunity for Black Women Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: November 11, 2020)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school senior or currently in college.
- B) Be a black woman in any field of study.

3) Elks Most Valuable Student Competition - \$50,000 - 500 Awards (Deadline: November 15, 2020)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be any high school senior who is a citizen of the United States is eligible to apply.
- B) Applicants need not be related to a member of the Elks.

4) Overachievers Student Grant - \$15,000 – 1 Award (Deadline: November 15, 2020)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be in middle school or high school.
- B) Be a person who is making a difference in others' lives outside of the classroom.

5) James Cox Student Photography Scholarships - \$2,500 - 11 Awards (Deadline: November 15, 2020)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) High school students applying for these scholarships must have completed one year at an accredited high school (student must therefore be a sophomore or older) and should have taken at least one photography or related art class.

6) Dr Juan Andrade Jr. Scholarship - \$1,000 - 20 Awards (Deadline: November 30, 2020)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be enrolled or accepted for enrollment as full-time undergraduate students, in an accredited institution in the U.S. or U.S. territories, and demonstrate a verifiable need for financial support.
- B) Have at least one parent of Hispanic ancestry.

7) Driver Education Initiative Scholarship - \$500 - 6 Awards (Deadline: November 30, 2020)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- B) Submit an essay demonstrating knowledge on the topic of Safe Driving.

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) An undergraduate student enrolled in an accredited two-year college, four-year college or a university; or a high school senior accepted for such enrollment.
- B) Pursuing, or planning to pursue, a course of study leading toward a career in physics teaching in the high schools.

- B) Be interested in designing and building things.
