Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2021-22 educational progress for the Ontonagon Area School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Jim Bobula, Superintendent or Jon Uotila, Principal for assistance.

The AER is available for you to review electronically by visiting the following website www.oasd.k12.mi.us or you may review a copy in the main office at your child's school.

For the 2021-22 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2018-19. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2017-18. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2016-17. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.

Being a very small rural school district with a population of students less than 300 can be a blessing and a curse. Ontonagon Area School is a Schoolwide Title I school building. Having a small population allows our Regular Ed, Title I and At Risk support personnel to educate our students utilizing small group and individualized instruction. The data in the following reports represent some of our areas of need, as well the areas of success. The data does not identify real numbers per group and does not identify real numbers or percentages when a minimum number is not represented. Our teachers are very aware of each student's needs at each grade level. We monitor reading and math proficiency on a

weekly and quarterly basis. This ensures that each student receives the necessary support to achieve academic proficiency.

We have established a science goal through the MICIP (Michigan Continuous Improvement Plan). We have updated our science curriculum with new books and materials. Elementary also utilizes Mystery Science lessons and projects to enhance their science curriculum.

The district would like to thank our staff, students, parents and community members for navigating the past two difficult school years through the COVID pandemic. We are dedicated to providing support and creating programs in order to enhance our student's educational experience here at the Ontonagon Area School District.
