The total time allotted for public comment shall be 30 minutes and, therefore, time for oral presentation may be limited to less than five (5) minutes to accommodate individuals wishing to address the Board.

Upon request to the Superintendent, the District shall make reasonable accommodation for a disabled person to be able to participate in this meeting.

This policy is adopted to allow the Board of Education to comply with Section 8 of 15.268 of the General School Laws of the State of Michigan.
