

MI Back on Track - 23G Grant

The MI Kids Back on Track grant funds (MCL388.1623g) will support programs provided before school, during school, after school, or during the summer. These funds are designed to address unfinished learning, get students to grade-level academic standards, provide additional academic assistance to students at risk of falling behind their peers, or help high school students prepare for postsecondary education.

The Ontonagon School District has applied for funding in October 2023. The funding, if awarded, would be utilized to support an Intensive intervention program and a summer program to address unfinished learning. The learning plan will focus around unfinished learning in the areas of Math and Literacy under the idea of a full MTSS (Multi-Tiered Systems of Support) system. When awarded the district will work to provide more details regarding the plan to families and the community.
